

Fly of the Month, October

Partridge and Orange

Fly Type - Wet Flies

Source - Originated in the UK for Trout and Grayling.

Hackle - Brown Partridge.

Hook - #12-16

Wing/Body - 6/0 - 8/0 Orange

Tying Instructions

1. Tie the thread in just behind the eye.
2. Take the thread down the shank to just opposite the point in neat touching turns.
3. Hold the hackle by the tip and gently stroke the fibers back.
4. Catch in the hackle by the tip and make no more than 2 to 2 1/2 turns.
5. Tie off and whip finish.



Fishing method

Fished upstream or across, the hackle pulsates in the current and probably is taken as a hatching Blue Winged Olive.
