

Fly of the Month, October – Yellow Sally

Hook: Size 12 -14 light wire, dry fly hook, X2 long shank, Down turned eye.

Thread: 6/0 Brown.

Tail: Deer body hair.

Tag: Red dubbing.

Body: Yellow foam.

Underwing: Krystal Flash - Pearl color.

Wing: Deer body hair.

Legs: Rubber legs - yellow.



#1

Photo # 1 Tie in a bed of thread to the top of the bend with a 6" long tag end remaining. Do not trim off the excess tag end. It will be the counter wrap thread winding over the body later. See Photo # 5 for example.



#2

Photo # 2 Tie in a short tail of cleaned and stacked deer body fur.



#3

Photo # 3 Dub in a small red tag for an egg sack. Tie in a fine strip of yellow foam and bring the thread to the hook eye.

Photo # 4 Wrap the foam tightly forward to the hook eye.



#5

Photo # 5 Use the excess tag of thread to counter wrap forward the foam body for the rib.



#6

Photo # 6 Tie in 3 strands of the Krystal Flash doubled over to make six strands. Trim to make even with the tail.

#7

Photo # 7 Tie in a deer hair wing to the tip of the tail. Trim the front excess as a Caddis Style fly.

#8

Photo # 8 Tie in the legs. Whip finish over the legs and add a small amount of head cement on the thread windings under the fly. This is the completed fly.
